How to get a LUNARC account and request software access

To access Aurora with thinlinc you first need a LUNARC account. When thinlinc is used to access Aurora, both a regular password and a one-time-password in shape of a cell-phone text message (Swedish: sms) is required for user identification.

- 1. Login to SUPR
- 2. Click on "Accounts" in SUPR left-hand menu
- 3. Click "Request Account at Lunarc"
- 4. Fill in the form:
 - a. Suggest usernames
 - b. add your mobile phone number
- 5. Accept SNIC User Agreement (if not already done)
 - a. Enter Personal Information in SUPR
 - b. Click "Handle User Agreement"
 - c. Click "Register SWAMID Identity" and login with your university credentials
 - d. Click "Confirm registration"
 - e. Check, read and accept the SNIC User Agreement by fill-in checkboxes and press Accept
- 6. A user account will be created at Lunarc check your email
- 7. You will get an email with a phone number to Lunarc. Call the number to receive your Lunarc password from a Lunarc employee.
- 8. To access software included in PReSTO at Lunarc please email support@lunarc.lu.se and request access to PReSTO
- 9. Use thinling to access Lunard with you Lunard username and password and an sms code (six digits) send at thinling login to your cell phone
- 10. Thinlinc can be downloaded from here https://www.cendio.com/thinlinc/download
- 11. At Aurora one-time-passwords is also required for data transfer using rsync (or scp), i.e. whenever you are identified as a user by Aurora.
